We have a commitment to addressing power imbalances	We recognise the impact of power differentials between clients, staff employed in lived experience positions and other disadvantaged groups
	• We value and promote unique perspectives and the diversity of experience with CoP members
	• We are committed to elevating the voices of people with a lived experience of trauma into designing and delivering the legal assistance sector services
